






1 CIRCUIT MAS DEL SENYOR, CLOT DE MAIG, DUNES DEL PEBRET and TORRE BADUM

Start: Urbanización Font Nova Difficulty: Medium Finish: Urbanización Font Nova Route: Circular Distance: 14.6 km



Description of the route: In the town of Peñíscola, following the signs for the natural park and before arriving at the Font Nova development, we find a Natural Park sign indicating the entrance to the Protected Natural Area.

It is recommended you leave your vehicle at this point and start the route, in the direction of Font Nova.

The first of the stops is at Mas del Señor. After a rest in this dark elm grove, we retrace our steps, until we come to the intersection that indicates the way to Badum tower; from here, the route runs along an old path that leads to the area called Clot

We continue the descent until we reach the first coast line. Once there, we take the trail to the right in order to visit the dunes of Playa del Pebret, which are only 500 m away. Then, we go back until we reach the emblematic Badum tower. Continuing along the trail, we return to the beginning of the route.

2 ROUTE FARO D'IRTA, CALA CUBANITA, FONT DE LA PARRA

Start: Cala Blanca Finish: Cala Blanca Distance: 12.5 km



Difficulty: Easy

Route: Linear

Description of the route: Taking the N-340 road, we arrive at the detour indicating Alcossehre. From there, we head in the direction of the Las Fuentes development, and we follow the signs for the Natural Park until we arrive at Cala Blanca, in the vicinity of the Irta lighthouse. The route begins at the lighthouse. We cross the Malentivet ravine that flows into the well-known Mundina cove (geographical boundary of the Serra d'Irta National Park). The path runs parallel to the sea at all times. One of the most representative enclaves is the Serradal beach, a spectacular place which features a tall mound of rounded stones, slowly eroded by the sea, and a collection of sand and shells that wash up and accumulate among the rocks. This part of the route is very gentle and suitable for walking with small children.

Once past the Prestige apartments, the path passes over a rocky area, drawing closer to the sea until arriving at Cala Cubanita. Setting out from the Cubanita cove, we come upon the forest trail and a sign that indicates Font de la Parra, which traces a path along the channel of the ravine. The route back also descends parallel to the ravine, until arriving at the intersection with the forest trail that leads us back to the starting

CIRCUIT CASTILLO DE PULPIS - BARRANCO DEL BOIXAR



Altitude (m) - Distance (km) Distance projected 7.767 km – Accumulated ascent 391 m - Maximum altitude 428 m – Minimum altitude - 135 m

Description of the route: From the town of Santa Magdalena de Pulpis, we head out


We cross the highway via the underpass, where we find the sign for the start of the path. We walk along dry farming land, until the path narrows and we enter the ravine. Along the route, we find remains of what were once lime kilns, now transformed into

The ascent in the shade here is quite pleasant. However, when we reach the last stretch, before arriving at the castle, the slope becomes more pronounced. From the castle, we pass between the walls of old corrals, as we head in the direction of the Boixar Ravine. We continue along the stretch of trail in the direction of San Antoni until we reach the intersection with Vistahermosa. Following this path, we find the detour towards the Boixar ravine (left). The descent through this ravine is quite smooth and ends at the service road to the AP-7 motorway. We return via the service road until we reach the municipal cemetery.

4 CIRCUIT CASTILLO DE XIVERT - ASSAGADOR DE LA SERRA

Start: N-340 Road, km 1023 Finish: N-340 Road, km 1023 Distance: 9.4 km

Dificultad: Medium



Description of the route: On the N-340 road, direction Castellón-Vinaroz, and past the entrance to the town of Alcalà de Xivert, we see the Seat and Renault dealerships. There, we find the sign indicating Xivert Castle. We begin the walk along a paved road that leads to the passage under the highway. Once we have crossed it, we turn left, along the road that runs parallel to the motorway, until we find the sign that indicates the climb to the castle.


The route runs along the north face of the mountain, in a gentle, continuous ascent

The descent passes through the old "Assagador de la Serra", a road once used to drive cattle, offering magnificent views of the town of Alcalà de Xivert before us and the Islamic fortress behind.

ROUTE LA ERMITA DE SANTA LLÚCIA I SANT BENET

Start: Urban. Montemar - c. Oliveres Finish: Urban. Montemar - c. Oliveres

Difficulty: Medium




Description of the route: Upon entering Alcossebre from the N-340 road, we encounter a roundabout, where we turn in the direction of the Las Fuentes development. After 5 km, we find a wooden sign on the left; this sign coincides with Oliveres street (Montemar development). At the end of this street, where the asphalt ends, we find the path that will take us to the hermitage of Santa Llúcia and Sant

This route rewards us with some splendid views. The coastline stretches from Oropesa to the d'Irta lighthouse in Alcossebre.

6 CIRCUIT ALTO DE VISTAHERMOSA - ERMITA DE SANT ANTONI


Start: Urbanización Nerea Finish: Urbanización Nerea



Description of the route: From the town of Peñíscola we head along the coastal road in the direction of the Natural Park. We take the detour to enter the Nerea development. After leaving our vehicle at the end of the development, we take the path to the right, in the direction of the Baltasar corral.

We continue our ascent, along the "bassa groga", until we reach the intersection of Vistahermosa. At this point, we begin to make our descent in the direction of the hermitage of Sant Antoni. When we leave the hermitage, we head down the main trail until we return to the starting point.

ROUTE LAS CRESTAS DE LA SERRA D'IRTA



Difficulty: High Distance: 18.8 km




Description of the route: Entering Alcossebre from the N-340 road, we get off at the roundabout, in the direction of the Las Fuentes development. From there, in the town of Alcossebre, we follow the signs for the Natural Park and for, finally, the hermitage of Santa Llúcia and Sant Benet. We can leave our vehicle in the vicinity of the hermitage. From the parking area, we see the first wooden sign that indicates the beginning of the

The route takes us past the Ebrí tower, until we arrive at the highest peak of the Sierra Campanilles (geodesic point). The wooden signs serve as a reference to follow the path We can still enjoy the views from the highest points of the sierra until we reach the Coll de la Palma, and from here to the Mallada de la Rabosa, where the path becomes a trail. Next, we again follow the signs indicating the path, until we arrive at the hermitage of Sant Antoni. It is not a very difficult route, although the distance to hike is considerable.

8 ROUTE LA CARRERA - PICO CAMPANILLES



Difficulty: Medium/High Route: Linear



Description of the route: On the N-340 road, direction Castellón - Vinaroz and just past the entrance to the town of Alcalà de Xivert, we encounter a detour sign to the right (a 90° turn), indicating the Calvario hermitage. Following this paved road (on the way to l'Estopet), we pass by the hermitage and cross the AP-7 bridge overpass. After going another 1.8 km, we come to the detour sign indicating Xivert Castle. Staying on the paved road, after another 2.1 km we come to a wooden sign indicating the Carrera Ravine. We leave our car here and start walking.

The ascent via the ravine allows us to enjoy the lush vegetation, and, at the top, on the left, we find the sign that indicates the Campanilles, the highest peak in the natural park (572 m).

BICYCLE ROUTE: RUTA DEL CRANC

Start: Playa de Las Fuentes Finish: Cala Volante



Distance: 17.8 km

Difficulty: Fasy

Altitude (m) - Distance (km) Projected Distance 17.81 km – Accumulated ascent 227 m - Maximum altitude 89 m – Minimum altitude 0 m


Description of the route:

Before arriving at the Alcossebre lighthouse in the Las Fuentes development, you can take up the Ribamar trail. At its starting point, you can find signs indicating the route by bike. This trail runs parallel to the coast and takes us to Cala Volante (geographical boundary of the Serra d'Irta National Park) and, from there, along the road to the town of Peñíscola.

The only difficulty this route presents is the ascent to Torre Badum; this stretch of steep slope comes just after the Pla de Pebret.

BICYCLE ROUTE: RUTA DEL XORIGUER

Start: Santa Magdalena de Pulpis Distance: 25.6 km Finish: Alcalà de Xivert Difficulty: High



Projected Distance 25.56 km – Accumulated ascent 675 m - Maximum altitude 369 m – Minimum altitude 125 m

Description of the route: The route begins in the town of Santa Magdalena de Pulpis, specifically on the service road that runs parallel to the highway. It continues along this road, heading south for 2 km, until arriving at a point where you can access the N-340 road or turn off to the left.

We continue on the left; up ahead a few meters, there is a detour to the right, but you must go straight. The route passes close to the Ametler lookout point and a water tank used for wildfire prevention.

Next, there is a fork in the road; take the road on the right, which passes through the 'corral de la Viuda' and arrives at Xivert Castle.

After passing the castle, you continue down the trail until you get to the l'Estopet path, which has an asphalt surface, and then pass by the Calvari hermitage, before arriving finally at the town of Alcalà de Xivert.


BICYCLE ROUTE: RUTA DEL FARDATXO

Start: Playa de las Fuentes Finish: Urbanización Font Nova



Distance: 16 km

Difficulty: Medium



Altitude (m) - Distance (km) Projected Distance 16.04 km - Accumulated ascent 393 m - Maximum altitude 221 m - Minimum altitude 4 m

Description of the route: From the coast of Alcossebre, via the Ribamar trail, you can enter the Serra d'Irta National Park.

Following this trail parallel to the coast, a very sharp curve brings us closer to Cala Argilaga; immediately after, we come upon a detour to the left, indicating Font d'en

Later, we come to another fork in the road on the right; here we find the Caseta recreational area.

With this detour behind us, we continue along this path, past the Pou del Moro and Mas del Senyor, until we arrive at the Font Nova development.
